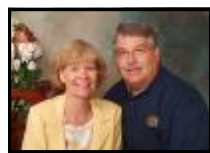

Hmmm.....

I had a young student that had made a habit of "pitching a fit" every morning when Mom would deliver her to my classroom. Her mother would hug, kiss, make unrealistic promises, and practically beg her daughter to please stop crying and calm down. Exactly 10 minutes after her mom left, the little "angel" would be totally fine, enjoying the classroom activities and friends.

On one such morning, the little girl was throwing a fit of such royal proportions that children in the classroom across the hall were watching with interest. When their teacher asked the children what they were doing, one astute little boy replied, "I'm watching a problem...":

I was amazed and amused at the little boy's accurate account of the drama being played out that morning. Sometimes I see moms literally throw up their hands and say—in front of their child—"I don't know what to do with this child!" Every mom in the world has moments she really doesn't know what to do, but admitting it in front of the child creates more problems than it solves.

The sheriff's office in a Texas city once distributed a list of rules entitled,

"How to Raise a Juvenile Delinquent in Your Own Home."

Here's the list:

- 1. Begin in infancy to give the child everything he/she wants. This will ensure them believing that the world owes them a living.*
- 2. Pick up everything they leave lying around. This will teach them they can always throw off responsibility on others.*
- 3. Take their side against your spouse, neighbors, teachers and those in authority. They are all prejudiced against your child. He or she is just a "free spirit" and is never really wrong.*
- 4. Finally, prepare yourself for a life full of grief. You're going to have it!*
